

SKILLSUSA LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE PROMOTIONAL POSTER REGULATIONS

OBJECTIVE: Each school will design a poster representing this year's SkillsUSA theme.

GENERAL RULES: Each school in attendance has the option to be entered in this contest. The poster will promote CTE and this year's SkillsUSA theme. The current years SkillsUSA Theme can be found here: https://www.skillsusa.org/resources/member-resources/theme/
Follow the contest requirements below.

- 1. Originality & Creativity
 - Your design should be your own work.
 - Make it visually unique, engaging, and aligned with the SkillsUSA theme.
- 2. Professional Appearance
 - o Poster should be neat, well-organized, and polished.
 - Use balanced spacing, readable fonts, and a cohesive color scheme.
 - Avoid clutter or excessive decoration.
- 3. SkillsUSA Branding
 - The word SkillsUSA must appear following official logo/brand guidelines (correct colors, font, and format). Logo and Brand Guidelines can be found here: https://brandfolder.com/skillsusa/skillsusa-brand-assets
 - o Do not alter or distort the SkillsUSA logo.
 - The SkillsUSA Theme is used to convey a message
- 4. School Identification
 - Your school name must be clearly shown on the poster.
- 5. Size Limit
 - Poster cannot be larger than 12" x 15".
 - o Any smaller size is acceptable if it is proportional and legible.
- 6. Construction Rules
 - o Poster must be two-dimensional only (no 3D objects).
 - No moving parts (must be flat and static).
- 7. Presentation
 - The final poster should look ready for display in a professional or competitive setting.
 - o Double-check spelling, grammar, and alignment.

Winners of Poster Competition will be announced at the Closing Ceremony.
